DETERMINING RISK FOR VICTIMS & PETITIONERS
\square Review the Lethality Assessment (LAP) or ask Police/Prosecutors for LAP info:
☐ LAP screened in as high-risk?
☐ Strangulation history? (#5)
☐ Firearms history (#1 and #4)
\square Review the OP, Warrant, and Defendant History for:
☐ Firearm in narrative(s) and/or OP #15
☐ Strangulation in narrative(s)
☐ Ask the Victim/Petitioner (if present and safe to do so):
☐ Does defendant/respondent own/possess firearms?
SETTING BOND & BOND CONDITIONS & CONSIDERING MOTIONS TO REDUCE BOND
☐ Risk to the Community TCA 40-11-118
☐ Shall consider defendant's prior criminal record and
\square Likelihood will pose a risk of danger to the community
☐ Risk to the Victim TCA 40-11-150
\square Shall review facts of the arrest and detention and
☐ Determine if the defendant is 1) A threat to the victim; 2) A threat to public safety; 3) Reasonably likely to appear in court.
☐ If Defendant currently on Bail TCA 40-11-148
☐ <i>Shall</i> set the defendant's bail on EACH new offense in an amount <u>not less than</u> <u>TWICE</u> that which is customarily set for the offense charged.
☐ Bond Conditions – <i>may</i> add bond conditions that mandate the defendant:
☐ Cannot possess firearms (state/federal law removes for granted OP, DV conviction)
☐ Must surrender and cannot obtain a new handgun carry permit
☐ Must stay away from victim – consider GPS monitoring to ensure

EVIDENCE BASED HIGH-RISK INDICATORS

- **Stalking** = 2x increased risk for murder
- **Sexual Violence** = 2x increased risk for murder
- **Access to firearms** = 5x increased risk for murder
- **Strangulation** = 7.5x increased risk for murder
 - Stranglers are *practicing or trying to kill* their victims
 - o Strangulation has life-threatening health effects
 - Strangulation does not require loss of consciousness or injury
- Threats to kill = 15x increased risk for murder
- **Threat or assault w/weapon** = 20x increased risk for murder
 - Tennessee is 11th in the country for the rate men kill women the vast majority of these murders are with a *firearm*
 - 54% of mass shootings are incidents where intimate partners and/or family members are targeted, even more have a history of domestic violence
