<u>Coordinated Entry for Survivors: Breaking the Cycle of Domestic Violence</u> and Homelessness

Domestic violence is one of the leading causes of homelessness for women and their children and being unable to obtain safe, affordable housing creates a substantial barrier to safety for survivors. To help address this barrier, Interpersonal Violence Coordinated Entry was created. This training explores the prevalence of homelessness and interpersonal violence, provides insight about how the domestic violence coordinated entry protocol is confidential, survivor-centered and trauma-informed, as well as how to get survivors connected to housing supportive services.
