

## **2020 Annual Report Summary**

In a year of constant change and challenge from a tornado to a global pandemic, the Metro Office of Family Safety (OFS) and its partners showed enormous resiliency and adaptation to virtual service provision, team meetings, and trainings. The Family Safety Center remained open while the court-based Jean Crowe Advocacy Center was forced to temporarily close. Even with these challenges, OFS's services, collaboration, and outreach grew substantially.
