## **Play Pyramid Volunteer – Position Description**

**Position Title:** Development Volunteer

**Department:** Office of Family Safety

### **Summary of Role:**

The Play Pyramid volunteer is responsible for working with the children who come to the Family Safety Center with their families to access domestic violence advocacy services

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

#### *Play Pyramid Responsibilities*

- Coordinate check-in/check-out systems for children in the Play Pyramid
- Facilitate age-appropriate activities as well as child-initiated play
- Communicate strengths of child to parents after each visit

#### *Additional Responsibilities if Children are not present*

- Make conversation with victims, especially those who are scared or emotional
- Assist in maintaining the cleanliness of the FSC, particularly the client Living Room area in order to provide a trauma-informed environment for clients
- Put out/refill snacks, pastries, and coffee for clients; Ensure that the center food is available to clients throughout the day
- Assist with sorting and putting away/putting out donation items
- Other duties and projects as requested

\*Potential opportunity for other projects/responsibilities at the discretion of the Resource Coordinator

### **Qualifications:**

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must pass a background check
